Having been with PEG since 2004, Mr. Hensley manages all of the company's residential energy programs and services; overseeing all PEG Energy Star programs as well as the certification of more than 10,000 homes a year in 23 different states. Mr. Hensley is a certified building inspector, master electrician, HERS Rater, ICC National Green Building Standard Verifier and Inspector, NFPA Life Safety Inspector, ICC/NAHB Green Verifier, RESNET Green Rater and has received the Masters Virginia Electrical and Masters Virginia Mechanical certification.

Some of Mr. Hensley's recent accomplishments include his role as the principal designer of the PEG Construction Risk Management program that has been used in 8 states for the regular and periodic inspections of 14 construction aspects of multi-family buildings. Mr. Hensley is both a RESNET and USGBC Quality Assurance Designee (QAD) and is frequently called upon as PEG's expert for construction defect litigation. In 2011 Mr. Hensley was confirmed into the RESNET Quality Assurance Committee which is responsible for interpreting Chapter 9 of the Mortgage Industry National Home Energy Rating Standards and overall oversight of RESNET's quality assurance program.
